

# Trip to Levens Hall Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September



Cost £32 per person

This trip has an early start at 8:30am & includes a guided tour of the house at 10:00am, later a guided tour of the garden in the afternoon by the Head Gardener,

Lunch is **not** included. They have a restaurant called Levens Kitchen which serves delicious dishes all freshly prepared on site, or if you prefer just bring a picnic.

This is a marvellous opportunity to have personally guided tours of both the house & the gardens. There will also be a stopover at Barton Grange Garden centre on the way home.

Located at the gateway to the Lake District National



Park, 5 miles south of Kendal in Cumbria, Levens Hall has grown from a stark, imposing Pele Tower built c1250-1300, into a warm and welcoming family home. This beautiful, privately-owned house and gardens is home to

the world's oldest topiary gardens and centre of a thriving 9,500-acre agricultural estate which provides much of the produce for Levens Kitchen.



In the afternoon, we make a short journey to Barton Grange Garden Centre for a couple of hours to browse and shop
